I. CALENDAR

Registration: November 17, 2021 – April 15, 2022.

Online round: May 1 - 20, 2022

Results will be announced on May 31, 2022.

The semifinal round takes place on September 10 and 11, 2022.

The final round takes place on September 13, 2022.

At the end of each round, the section secretary will announce the results, immediately after the Jury deliberation.

II. REPERTOIRE

The repertoire included in the registration form by the candidate is final and cannot be changed.

Chosen works for the Online Round are not to be repeated in the Semifinal Round.

Competitors may present their choice of works in any order.

All works shall be performed by memory, except the violin and piano sonatas and the works composed by George Enescu.

Online round (maximum duration: 70 min)

1. J. S Bach: at competitor's choice from:

- Adagio and Fugue from Sonata in G minor
- Grave and Fugue from Sonata in A minor
- Chaconne from Partita in D minor
- Adagio and Fugue from Sonata in C major

2. W. A. Mozart: First Movement with Cadenza from one of the following Violin Concertos (with piano accompaniment):

- no. 1 in B-flat major, K207
- no. 2 in D major, K211
- no. 3 in G major, K216
- no. 4 in D major, K218
- no. 5 in A major, K219

3. One complete Violin Sonata, at competitor's choice from:

- **L. van Beethoven:** one of the 10 violin and piano sonatas
- **Fr. Schubert:** one of the 3 Sonatinas or Sonata in A major

4. G. Enescu: *Menétrier* (The Fiddler) – the opening movement of the “*Impressions d'enfance*” Suite, op. 28

5. N. Paganini: one Caprice from the 24 Caprices for solo violin

3. A virtuoso work chosen by competitor among the following composers: Sarasate, Paganini, Saint-Saëns, Ernst, Ravel, Wieniawski, Schnittke, Milstein, Waxman or Tchaikovsky, Hindemith, Honneger, Hubay or Zimbalist

A concerto for violin and orchestra chosen by competitor among the following composers:
